Assistant Trader Program

Job summary

The Assistant Trader program develops you for a trading position in our market making and trading businesses. You will be introduced to the financial markets through a combination of practical training on a trading desk that is supported with ongoing theoretical classroom instruction. Openings for the Assistant Trader program are located at our headquarters in Bala Cynwyd, PA, just outside of Philadelphia, as well as in New York and Chicago.

The objective of the Assistant Trader program is to develop you into an autonomous decision-maker, capable of identifying profitable trading opportunities, assessing risk, and appropriately allocating firm capital.

You will be assigned to a trading desk where you will be responsible for daily activities that support our ongoing trading activity. You will work directly with a trader who is available to answer questions and provide you with feedback.

Two senior traders teach the theoretical classroom education, which is the core of the program. Your professional development is their full-time responsibility. Simulated trading sessions and classes that highlight the key elements of trading make up the program's curriculum. Class topics include option theory, decision science, corporate finance, game theory, and market structure.

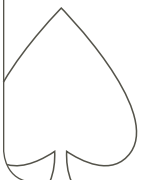
